- 1. An "Off the shelf" product for bone repair will not succeed if key processes involved in bone formation are imbalanced or inhibited. *This thesis*.
- 2. SLG alginate with collagen-based microspheres loaded with BMP-2 supports ectopic bone formation but it is not ideal for bone defect repair. *This thesis.*
- Scaffolds used as a delivery vehicle should be tailored according to specific needs, since a suboptimal choice will lead to a less effective bone formation process. This thesis.
- 4. Controlled-release systems, sustained-release systems and slow-release systems are not synonyms and they are not interchangeable. *This thesis.*
- 5. It is tricky to choose between donor variation in primary cells and possible abnormalities in immortalized cell lines. *This thesis*.
