## FROM BABY STEPS TO MATURE STRIDES

Maturation of drug metabolism and transport studied using innovative approaches

- 1. Pediatric [14C]microtracer studies can be used to safely study oral bioavailability and metabolism of drugs (this thesis)
- 2. Metabolite in safety testing (MIST) studies with [14C]microtracers are an interesting opportunity to increase efficacy and safety in pediatric drug development and current drug therapy (this thesis)
- 3. Variability in oral bioavailability of midazolam leads to unpredictable systemic exposure to midazolam and potentially other CYP3A-substrates after oral dosing in children (this thesis)
- 4. Transporter maturation patterns are isoform and organ dependent and can contribute to age-related differences in drug disposition (this thesis)
- 5. Developmentally regulated alternative splicing of *SLCO1B1* may have implications for the functional activity of the OATP1B1 transporter in children (*this thesis*)
- 6. Off-label drug use is not the same as off-evidence drug use (van der Zanden, Arch Dis Child 2017)
- 7. Pharmacists are experts on pharmacotherapy; they should be allowed to prescribe drugs based on the diagnosis provided by the physician
- 8. Optimal cooperation between universities and the pharmaceutical industry offers great opportunities at all stages of the drug development process (van der Meer, Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences 2005)
- 9. Buying a noise cancelling head phone is a good investment to survive a noisy open office (based on Harvard Business Review 2018)
- 10. Exercise is an effective way for students to cope with stress, especially during academic demanding times (Giacobbi, Psychology of Sport and Exercise 2007)
