- 1. Overanticoagulation with an international normalized ratio above 6.0 are associated with a decline of renal function (this thesis)
- 2. There is no increased risk of hyponatremia with chlorthalidone compared to hydrochlorothiazide in an equipotent blood pressure lowering dose (this thesis)
- 3. Increased serum uric acid levels are associated with the presence of a simple renal cyst (this thesis)
- 4. Benzodiazepines increase the risk of hyponatremia, especially when combined with thiazides (*this thesis*)
- 5. Renal function monitoring in patients using antihypertensive therapy might be substantially improved. (*this thesis*)
