## Falls in Older Persons: Associated Factors and the Effects of Drug Withdrawal

- 1. Withdrawal of fall-risk increasing drugs does not lower quality of life (this thesis).
- 2. Higher serum 25(OH)D concentrations are associated with better strength and physical performance in older men and women (*this thesis*).
