- 1. In pediatric intensive care, children are oversedated in approximately one third of observations (this thesis)
- 2. There is no beneficial effect of daily sedation interruption in addition to protocolized sedation for critically ill children (this thesis)
- 3. The midazolam clearance in critically ill children is up to 77% lower in the presence of inflammation and multi-organ failure (this thesis)
- 4. Interleukin-6 seems to play a regulatory role in CYP3A downregulation (this thesis)
- Increased drug concentrations owing to reduced clearance in critical illness do not necessarily lead to higher efficacy or toxicity, as pharmacodynamics can change concomitantly (this thesis)
- 6. The dose makes the poison (Paracelsus, 1493-1541)
- 7. A dedicated pharmacist in the ICU is essential and beneficial for the patients and the team (Chant, Intensive Care Medicine 2015)
- 8. None of the technical advances can begin to replace the caring physician, nurse and therapist at the bedside (Petty, Chest 1998)
- 9. Clowns or clown doctors significantly lessen children's anxiety in the operating room / hospital (Manyande, Cochrane 2015)
